
While Moses was with God on Mount Sinai the Israelites did something dreadful.




They ordered Aaron to make a golden calf -and they worshiped that instead of God.

As they neared Canaan, Moses sent twelve spies to see the land God promised to His





The spies all agreed it was beautiful! But only two, Joshua and Caleb, believed they could conquer the land with God's help.
