



You might expect Paul and Silas to be angry and bitter. But they weren't.





Suddenly, the singing stopped. God sent an EARTHQUAKE to shake the prison. All the doors were opened. Everyone's chains were loosed.








Sadly, the poor jailer pulled out his sword. He may as well kill himself and get it over with.







Released the next day, Paul and Silas traveled to many other cities, telling people about Jesus.






Some people believed, others tried to hurt them. But God was with His servants. One night, Paul preached for hours.
































Finally, Paul arrived at Rome. It took over two years for his court case to be heard.



During that time, Paul rented a house and received visitors.




Do you know what Paul told his visitors about? The kingdom of God! The Lord Jesus Christ!






"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith," Paul wrote from Rome.
