THEOLOGY - ISSUES

The following titles are the first volumes in a collection of works on theological issues influencing and influenced by the Reformation. While the controversial nature of these issues has meant they have been argued in every age of church history, they proved to be of particular significance during the Reformation era.

Andrews, J.N. — **History of the Sabbath**

Speaks to the significance of the Sabbath from many perspectives including those of the Reformers

Cassels, Samuel J. — **Christ and Anti-Christ**

1846. A Presbyterian Minister puts forth: 1) Christ as the Messiah, 2) a commonly held view concerning the identity of the Antichrist

Guinness, H. Grattan — **Romanism and the Reformation**

A series of lectures discussing possible plans and methods of Romanism from the prophecies of Daniel & Revelation

Howell, Robert Boyte C. — **The Evils of Infant Baptism**

Considers not the mode nor subject of baptism but the evils of baptizing infants and gives a perspective not seen today.

Standish, Russell R. — **Modern Bible Translations**

One perspective on the recent translations controversy. Author identifies the Reformation roots of this and related issues.
