The disciples woke Jesus, crying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!"



AND THE WIND CALMED ... THE SEA BECAME PEACEFUL AND STILL.


The disciples marveled, saying, "Who can this be,




Some time later, Jesus had another busy day. Over 5000 people had followed Him to a deserted place.




By God's power, Jesus fed that whole crowd using only one little boy's lunch. Now it was evening. Jesus sent everybody away.







When He had sent everybody away, Jesus went up on a mountain by Himself to pray. When evening had come. He was alone there.






