



It happened this way. About 120 followers of Jesus were praying together in a house. Suddenly, the house was filled with the sound of a rushing mighty wind.


Forked flames of fire rested upon each person. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit - just as Jesus promised!




But Peter said, "These are not drunk ... this is what was spoken of by the prophet Joel ..." Peter then reminded them that many years before, God had





