


The High Priest was so furious, he ordered them to be beaten and released.


In spite of their pain, the apostles obeyed God and carried on preaching about Jesus




One day a man called Stephen was arrested. Stephen loved the Lord Jesus. The Holy Spirit was using him to tell others about Jesus. Some
