


While Peter prayed on the house-top, God sent him a vision. It looked like a great sheet being lowered

to the earth. On the sheet were animals and birds. Peter could tell that these were "unclean".


That meant religious Jews were not allowed to eat them. Suddenly, a voice came to him.




"Stand up. I myself am also a man," Peter told Cornelius. Then he said to all the people in the house, "You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company




But God has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean."
