Point to self.
- Acts 9:17** . . . . . Point to someone else.

## LESSON 7

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- Come and stay at my house.** . . . . . Move hand toward chest.  
Point to self.

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- Do what is right.** . . . . . With palms down, move hands from side to side.  
Lift up right hand.

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- Encourage one another and build each other up.** . . . . . Point to others one at a time.  
Pound fists together as if hammering.  
Raise hands upward.

Point to self.  
Point to forehead.
- Psalms 119:169** . . . . . Palms together, then open.
