Genesis 2:1-3; Exodus 20:8-11; *Patriarchs and Prophets*, pp. 47, 48

We can do special things, eat special foods, and even wear special clothes. Let's see what we can learn about God's holiday. A special holiday. A holy holiday.

# The Message

## Memory Verse

# S A B B A T H

- READ** Find a quiet place in nature and read your lesson story with your family. Try to find things God made on each of the days of Creation.
- DO** Share your list of ideas for making Sabbath a special day. Ask your family to do one thing.
- DO** Teach your memory verse to your family.
- PRAY** Thank God for family time.

# S U N D A Y

- READ** During worship time, read and discuss Exodus 20:8 together.
- DO** Make a clock face out of stiff paper or a paper plate. Attach the hour and minute hands with a fastener. Write on the clock "Sabbath Begins At . . ." Find out when sunset comes this Friday. (Look at a sunset schedule or church bulletin.) Set the clock hands to that time. Put your clock on your refrigerator to remind you to be ready for Sabbath at sundown Friday.
- PRAY** Say your memory verse together. Thank God for His love and for the Sabbath.

# M O N D A Y

- READ** During family worship, ask someone to read about the first Sabbath (Genesis 2:1-3). Draw a picture of the first Sabbath. Write your memory verse at the bottom. Pray that you will think about Jesus every day this week, and that you will be ready for His special Sabbath time.
- DO** Ask your family to help you learn God's Sabbath commandment (Exodus 20:8-11).

Sabbath is so special we will keep it holy in the new earth (Isaiah 66:23).



# T U E S D A Y

- DO** Today would be a good day to give the invitation to Sabbath School to your friend. At worship tonight talk about your friend's response.
- THINK** Say your memory verse together. Tell your family: "Sabbath is a gift from God. I love Sabbath because \_\_\_\_\_."
- DO** Read or say together God's Sabbath commandment in Exodus 20:8-11. Then say this commandment in your own words. Thank God for His special holy holiday.

# W E D N E S D A Y

- SHARE** With your family read and discuss these texts. List what you discover about ways to worship God on Sabbath.

# T H U R S D A Y

**DO** With your family, make a Sabbath plan. Make sundown worship part of your Friday evening plans. Ask others in your family to do special things. Choose some songs.

**PRAY** Ask God to bless your plans.

# F R I D A Y

**DO** Light some candles for sundown worship. Say the fourth (Sabbath) commandment together. Follow the worship plans you made yesterday. As part of your worship, have your family join you in saying your memory verse.

**READ** Read Mark 2:27. Why did God make the Sabbath? Thank Him for it.

**PRAY** Is your friend coming to Sabbath School with you tomorrow? Pray for a happy Sabbath day.
